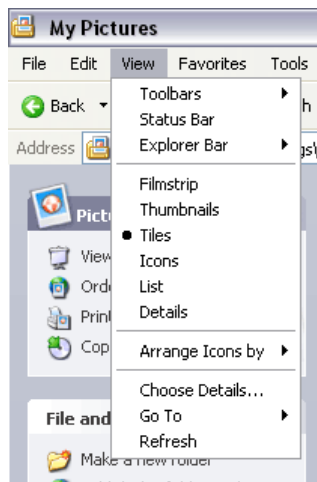
### Viewing photos on a computer

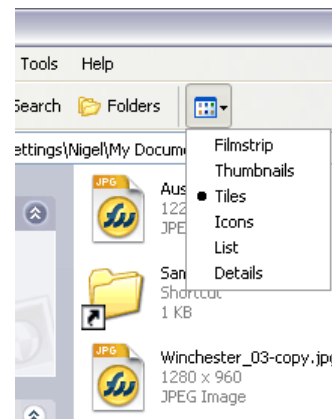
there are a few ways available for viewing photos after saving them on to a computer. These are: as *thumbnails*, as a *filmstrip* or as a *slideshow*.

#### View as Thumbnails

On the computer, open the folder containing the photos you wish to view. On the Menu, at the top of the window, click on View and choose Thumbnails. Or, click on the View button, on the Button Bar, and choose Thumbnails.



Choosing View from the Menu

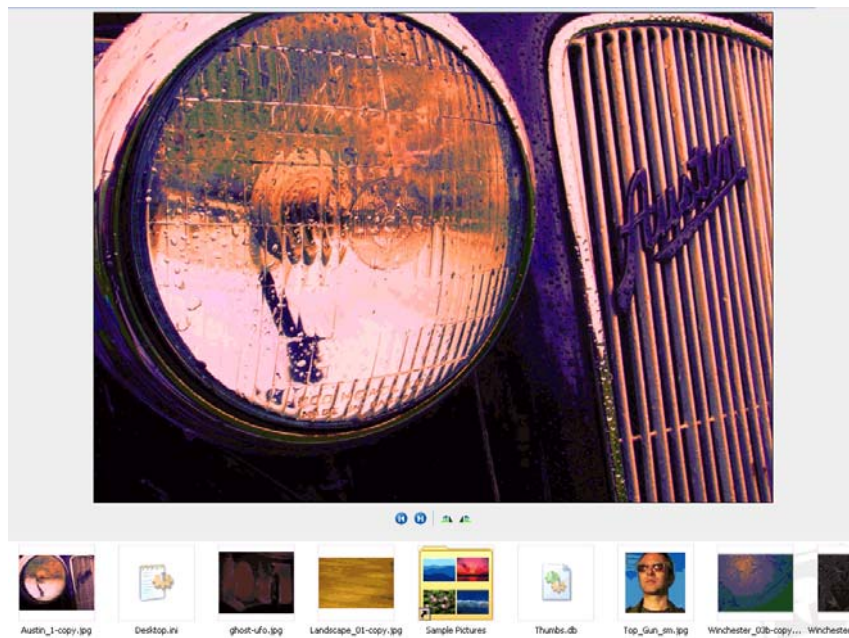


Choosing View from the Button Bar

#### View as a Filmstrip

Use the same method as choosing to view as thumbnails but choose Filmstrip instead. Doing this will replace the usual files view in the window with the filmstrip viewer.

Click on the back or next button to advance to another photo. It is also possible to rotate images as well.

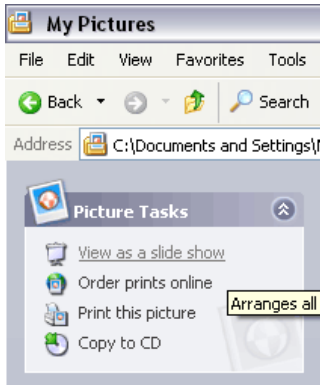




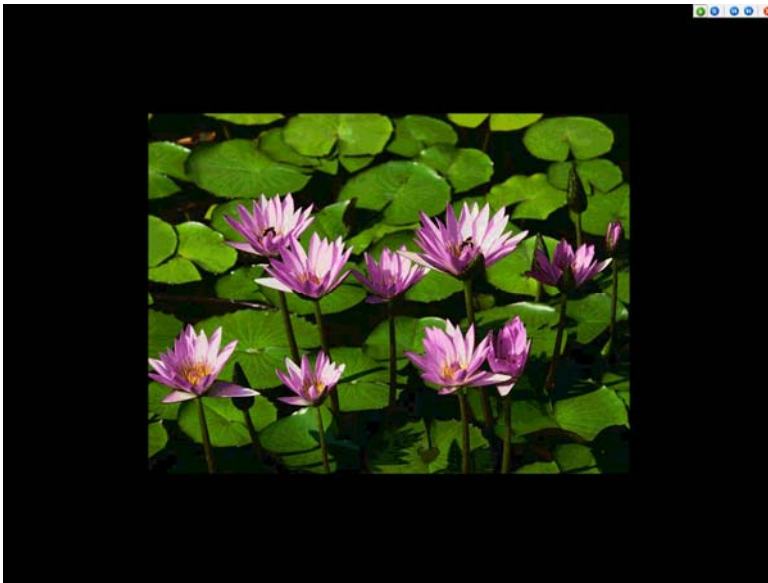
*Filmstrip control with back and forward buttons and two rotate buttons*

## View as a slideshow

To the left of the window is a panel called Picture Tasks.



Click on the first item, View as Slideshow, and the screen will turn black. Each photo in the folder will automatically appear in turn.



Move the mouse to view the Slideshow control to manually advance through photos or to exit the slideshow. The control will disappear if the mouse is kept still or no keys on the keyboard are pressed. To make the controller reappear, move the mouse or press a key.

You can also exit the slideshow by pressing the Escape key (Esc).
